

Members' Motions to the League Against Cruel Sports' AGM, Saturday 19 September 2026.

In preparation for the 2026 Annual General Meeting (AGM), members are invited to put forward motions for consideration. Your ideas will help shape a constructive and forward-looking discussion about the future of the League.

In order to submit a motion at the AGM we need from you the title, a brief explanation and a reason for your proposed motion by Friday 10 July 2026. Submissions must not exceed 200 words. Please use the form provided on the reverse to do this.

Then you, as the 'proposer' of the motion, need the support of one other Member to be the 'seconder' of your proposed motion. In accordance with our by-laws, each proposed motion must also be supported by the signatures of at least **1% of the League's membership*** in order to be included on the AGM agenda.

If your motion is accepted, you will be required to attend our online AGM on Saturday 19 September 2026 to formally present your motion for debate and voting.

**1% of the membership is 46 signatures. Members must not be in arrears with their membership payments. Signatories in support of the motion must provide their name and membership number. Proposers should collect the necessary signatures and submit them with the final version of their motion by the Friday 10 July 2026 deadline. There will be the opportunity for Members, in advance of the AGM, to submit amendments to accepted motions.*

Following feedback from our Members, this year's AGM will also include the launch of our new and improved motion and response process. Members told us they wanted a process that was easier to engage with, and we have listened. We look forward to sharing these improvements with you at the AGM and demonstrating how the updated process will support greater Member participation and engagement moving forward.

Understanding motion submissions

There is a limit to the number of resolutions which can be properly considered at the AGM. We sometimes receive suggestions for motions that:

- cover the same or very similar issues
- are contradictory
- appear to be based on misunderstandings or a lack of awareness of the League's existing policies
- are unclear.

Motions that meet the above criteria may not be accepted for consideration at the AGM. If you have any questions, or need further guidance, please do get in touch with us.
