## HOW TO MAKE A BIRD **NESTING BOX**



Birds need your care all year round. As their natural nesting sites become scarcer and scarcer, more of these incredible animals are relying on nesting boxes. Why not create your very own and display it in your garden to keep your feathered friends warm and safe?



- Sand down the hole so there are no splinters that could 4. injure the birds.
- Drill some 8 mm holes in the base of the bird box for drainage. 5.
- Nail or screw all the pieces together except for the roof. 6.
- Use the strip of rubber to make a hinge for between the roof and the 7. back of the bird box. You'll need this to clean the box out at the end of every nesting season.
- 8. Drill an 8 mm hole in each of the top corners of the back board of the bird box.
- 9. You can treat the bird box with linseed oil or wood preservative but be sure that it is non-toxic and safe for birds.
- **10.** Tie some strong cord through the holes in the back of the bird box and hang in a suitable location.
